

KIATA ETIQUETTE GUIDELINES

- Always take a sit down towel with you wherever you go. When you are nude, a towel must be used when sitting on any furniture indoors or outdoors (including pool and dam areas) or whatever may be regarded as a seat.
- If you are attending a function in the clubhouse, bring your own plates and cutlery. Then after the meal, wash up your own dishes in the clubhouse sink located outside the kitchen next to the drinks fridge.
- The last person using any of the club's BBQ's and utensils is to clean them after use.
- If you are invited to someone's place for a drink or meal, generally it's BYO everything unless the hosts specify otherwise. It is a courtesy to ask what to bring if invited to a members place.
- First names only are to be used within the club. If there are more than one person with the same name they are usually identified with his/her partner's name or a nickname.
- Photography is allowed so long as the subject(s) are consenting. If you are taking a photo, please ensure that there is no other person in the background. Photographing children by non family members is not permitted unless the parents are present and in agreement. Photos taken at Kiata are not to be published on public social media. The taking of photographs at club functions is only allowed by the official club photographer.
- No photographs of members sites unless approved by that member. There may be cars or some item that could be identified outside the club.
- Shower before using the spa or pool.
- Watch your children at all times as they are your responsibility.
- If you bring pets with you they are to be kept on a lead while you are walking them around the club and are excluded from the clubhouse and all eating areas as well as the pool/spa area. Pets are also NOT allowed in the rental vans. It is the pet owners responsibility to pick up any droppings left by their pet.
- Afternoon tea is on every Sunday at 3.30 pm and everyone is most welcome. A gold coin donation is requested and the first Sunday of each month is Tim Tam Sunday.
- All rubbish must be taken with you after a function. Bottles that are eligible for Return and Earn may be left next to the BBQ,s outside the kitchen in the tubs provided. Money earned from these goes back to the club to purchase consumables for the kitchen. Skip bins are provided to put your rubbish in at the Sin Bin area although it is preferred you take it home as they fill very quickly. Bringing rubbish from your home to put into the skip bins is not allowed and will not be tolerated.
- Smoking is permitted in the designated smoking areas only and butts are to be deposited in the tubs provided.
- Cars are NOT to be driven within the grounds once you have arrived. The exception to this is if you have a disability in which case there are designated parking spaces available.
- Please obey the 'NO PARKING' signs and speed limit.
